

Cookies

To make this site work properly, we sometimes place, like many others, small data files called cookies on your device.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site.

How do we use cookies?

A number of our pages use cookies: to **remember your display preferences**, such as contrast colour settings or font size. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

We use **Piwik**, **Wysistat** and **Google analytics** to examine the user profiles and the way you browse our content, in order to improve the UX and our 'Web appeal'.

Also, some videos embedded by **Adobe's Flash** in our pages, use a cookie to anonymously gather statistics on how you got there and what videos you visited.

In order to protect your private life, you can set most browsers to prevent a selection of cookies from being placed.

You can block them and disable Flash, without disturbing your browsing experience. Enabling these cookies is not strictly necessary for our website to work.
