1794 - The Cnam was founded

1968 - Creation of Cnam Center abroad (CCE - Centre Cnam à l'Etranger) in Lebanon

1975 - Initiation of the Cnam Intec and INP-HB partnership in Côte d'Ivoire

2002 - Creation of the Institut International du Management (IIM)

2003 - First MBA in English at the IIM

2004 - First international MA in Management at the IIM

2005 - Creation of the CCE (Cnam center abroad) in Morocco

2008 - Creation of the CCE in Madagascar

2010 - Creation of the international relations department of the Cnam

2015 – First international MA in Engineering sciences: Telecom-Network

2015 – Creation of the CCE in Côte d'Ivoire

**2016** – Creation of the European Pole within the DDEI (International and European Development Department)

2017 - Creation of the CCE in China

**2021** – Creation of 2 other international MAs in engineering sciences: Mechanics and Information Technology
